TOURISM INDUSTRY RECOVERY AGENDA

- Released ahead of State Election and underpinned advocacy to all political parties.
- Identified five policy priorities to provide the required support to restart and recover SA's tourism industry from the effects of the pandemic.

NATIONAL JOBS & SKILLS SUMMIT

- TiCSA CEO attended Tourism Jobs Summit in Canberra. Discussion informed National Jobs and Skills summit and formulated ways to alleviate the skills and workforce shortages impacting tourism operators nationwide.
- Agreed key outcomes established, to guide to work of tourism councils and associations across
 Australia.

PRE-ELECTION POLICY FORUM BREAKFASTS

- Two events held; one with Premier, and other with Leader of Opposition & Shadow Minister.
- Tourism policies presented and discussed.

STATE GOV. PARTNER -SHIP AGREEMENT

- Signed agreement to work collaboratively to invest, excel and grow visitor economy.
- 'Breakfast with the Minister' events in Clare, Berri and Mannum.

- Submission provided to inform tourism regulation review, including recommendations to reduce 'red tape' for tourism operators
- 10 Regional Roadshows held in 2021-22 across the state's regions and online to give regional operators the opportunity to speak with local MPs and Shadow Tourism Minister on the issues affecting their electorate

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INDUSTRY RESPONSE AND RECOVERY ADVOCACY

- TiCSA CEO member representation on Industry Response and Recovery Council. Advocated for support on behalf of the tourism industry.
- \$90,000 State Government funding support for Business Boost business development programs.
- TiCSA CEO presented at Budget & Finance Committee as part of the Legislative Council.

RELIEVE FINANCIAL PRESSURES ON THE STATE'S TOUR OPERATORS WHO SIGNIFICANTLY STRUGGLED DURING THE PANDEMIC

- NATIONAL TOURISM INDUSTRY COUNCIL JOBKEEPER **EXTENSION PETITION**

- Wrote to State Government encouraging waiving of fees for tourism businesses.
- Waiver of annual vehicle fees for a 12-month period, and National Park fees
- Over 10,000 signatures were collected, demonstrating the industry's need for JobKeeper support



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VISITOR ECONOMY COALITION ESTABLISHED

• A coalition of representatives from 13 different areas of the industry formed and regularly met to work collaboratively to address issues of significance to the visitor economy.
